4. Research and develop in-house incubation toolkits for Start Up! social entrepreneurs.

5. Develop sector maps to build intelligence on key trends, challenges, and players in the eco-system.
6. Build communication and social media strategies for Start Up! as well as its clients and partners.

Knowledge, skills and attributes required

- Willingness and enthusiasm to learn and engage with social change models, both for-profit and not-for-profit.
- Self-starter with a strong work ethic.
- Strong problem solving, analytical, and interpersonal skills.
- Strong communication skills.
- Ability to multi-task and handle deadlines across two or more projects.
- Ability and willingness to adhere to timelines.
- Excellent skills in MS Office/equivalent applications, especially MS Excel, MS Word and MS PowerPoint.
- Knowledge of written and spoken English; knowledge of additional Indian languages will be a plus.
- Willingness to travel to rural India.

Minimum education qualification and work experience requirements

- Fellows from academic backgrounds and training in business management, economics, international development and other related domains will be preferred.
- Prior experience with a social enterprise will be an advantage; Individuals with 3+ years of work experience will be given priority.
