



ANNE SMEDINGHOFF MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Available to Incoming Seniors

The family and friends of Anne Smedinghoff, a 2005 Fenwick graduate, have established a \$2,000 scholarship in her name to be used toward next year's tuition for a rising senior with an interest in pursuing a career in international relations and/or public service.

Anne was an outstanding student at Fenwick and the leader/officer of the International Relations Club, a members of the National Honor Soceity, the cross country team and a National Merit Semi-Finalist. Anne attended Johns Hopkins University in Maryland, majoring in International Studies. She was a key organizer in the University's annual Foreign Affairs Symposium.

Upon graduation she entered Foreign Service; her first assignment was in Caracas, Venezuela. She sought, and was granted, a posting in Afghanistan. While traveling in a convoy delivering math and science books to children in Qatar Provence, she and three other Americans died after the detonation of a car bomb.

Secretary of State John Kerry described her as a "selfless, idealistic young woman...who set out to bring textbooks to children to bring them knowledge." Governor Pat Quinn praised her as having lived a "purposeful life".

Students applying for this scholarship should have:

- A strong academic record
- An interest in international affairs, public service or political science
- A record of service activities here or in their community
